

2006 FormulaCar Magazine FSCCA Championship Series

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Purpose: The 2006 FormulaCar Magazine FSCCA Championship Series will promote and publicize competition among FSCCA owners/drivers.

A completed entry must contain the following:

- a. The check for the \$50. Entry fee should be made payable to SCCA Enterprises.
- b. Each entrant must declare a division to compete in.
- c. The entry form and W-9 filled out legibly, and signed.
- d. Each driver must send 4 pictures, one of the driver (head shot), and 3 pics of the racecar (2 side views and 1 front view). The pics must be emailed electronically (in jpeg format) via email (see entry form for addresses).
- e. The entry form, entry fee, driver bio, and W-9 must be mailed to SCCA Enterprises.

The completed entry must be postmarked on or before the entry deadline, to the appropriate address. No entries will be accepted after the deadline. Results of official 2006 FormularCar Magazine FSCCA Championship Series races run before the deadline will be counted retroactive. The entry deadlines are:

Central Division—July 31st

Northeast Division—July 10th

Southeast—April 24th

Southwest—May 8th

Prize money, if applicable, will not be paid unless the entry form is completed in full, including the tax identification number. A completed W-9 must also be on file with SCCA Enterprises.

These vehicles will be raced in compliance with the 2006 SCCA Club Racing GCR National Formula SCCA Rules.

SCCA Enterprises reserves the right, in its reasonable discretion, to amend or modify the Rules and Regulations for the 2006 FormularCar Magazine FSCCA Championship Series at any time via Tech Bulletins or Competitor Bulletins that will be posted on <http://www.eformulacarnews.com> and/or <http://www.sccaenterprises.com> . Updates requiring series decals will be made with appropriate timing and distribution information.

The 2006 FormularCar Magazine FSCCA Championship Series will be contested in four divisions, each with a Division Championship. The official events in each division are listed in the appendix. Each division will have eight official races.

Points, for each race, will be earned based on the SCCA Points System (12, 9, 7, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1) places one thru nine. Places will be determined by the finishing position of just FSCCA racecars in the race from the Official Results (as per the 2006 GCR). Non-entered FSCCA competitors will not be scored, but will displace registered drivers who finish behind them.

On race weekends with multiple races being contested, SCCA Enterprises will indicate via Competitor Bulletins (<http://www.eformulacarne.com> and/or <http://www.sccaenterprises.com>) which race or races are the official races to score for the 2006 FormularCar Magazine FSCCA Championship Series.

The Divisional Championship Points will be the addition of the best 8 races, (of which 2 races may be out of division races in official 2006 FormularCar Magazine FSCCA Championship Series events), for each entered driver. There is also a "wildcard" (SCCA Enterprises Spec Festival at HPT) event that can count as in Division races. (Spec Festival details to follow: \$99 Entry, three days track time, single car qualifying...)

Ties for 1st Place in the Division Points Championship will be decided by the number of first place finishes; then if necessary, the number of second place finishes, etc. For ties with 2nd or 3rd place, the prize money will be added, for the tied positions, and divided equally.

The purse structure for the 2006 FormularCar Magazine FSCCA Championship Series is listed in the APPENDIX. In addition to the purse, the top 3 drivers in each race will receive awards at the National FSCCA Championship event at Road Atlanta (the ARRC), November 10th.

It will be the responsibility of the driver/owner to:

1 st Place	*\$1,500	-----	\$3,000 with bonus
2 nd Place	*\$750	-----	\$1,500 with bonus
3 rd Place	*\$250	-----	500 with bonus

Divisions with ten or more total series entrants

1 st Place	*\$2,500	-----	\$5,000 with bonus
2 nd Place	*\$1,250	-----	\$2,500 with bonus
3 rd Place	*\$500	-----	\$1,000 with bonus

Place winners in each division will be paid a bonus equal to their winnings if they attend the National FSCCA Championship event at Road Atlanta (the ARRC), November 10th.
